

Will It Fit Guide?



Bracelets and Bangles

Measuring a child or baby's wrist is the best way to determine if the jewellery will fit. This is especially important for personalised jewellery as we are unable to accept returns on these items as they are engraved to order.

To get the best results, go to **Printing Settings** before printing this page and make sure the **Page Scaling** option is set to **none** in the print dialogue box. The scale is correct if the credit card and length match.

Measure a wrist with our MBL ruler

- Cut out the ruler
- For bangles wrap the ruler around the widest part of a child's hand, with the numbered side visible.
 Baby Bangles are designed to expand to fit, but should not be forced to a smaller size than the smallest measurement indicated in the product specifications as this risks damaging the product.
- The numbered lines on the pink side are the measurements of the circumference of the bangle laid flat, when they line up with the edge of the ruler you will be able to gauge the largest size that the bangle will expand to and the smallest size it will sit at.
- **For bracelets** wrap the ruler around the circumference of the wrist with the numbered side visible.
- All bracelets have three adjusters that are designed to fit most ages and sizes. Please refer to the individual product specifications to see which measurements are applicable.
